As a young child in Sunday School, I remember heartily singing a jaunty little song with the words, 'God loves a cheerful giver; give it all you've got!'. It has stuck with me and, recently, I have found myself humming that song...and thinking about the theme of 'generosity'. In the letter that Rev Lisa Kerry wrote to MBC recently, she wrote 'God has been outrageously generous to us and it is right for us to be generous to each other." However, as followers of Jesus, I wonder how often we stop to consider the countless gifts that God, our good father, has showered upon us.
